

Environmental group plans protest at AMD luncheon

SARATOGA SPRINGS—A group called Saratoga Greens, which is affiliated with the Green Party, plans a demonstration at a luncheon for Advanced Micro Devices Inc. executives.

The Saratoga Economic Development Corp. will hold the luncheon Tuesday at the Saratoga Springs City Center. The purpose of the event is to allow community leaders to meet AMD representatives, who will be in town next week talking to state and local officials, and local media.

AMD, based in Sunnyvale, Calif., is planning a \$3.2 billion computer chip factory for the Luther Forest Technology Campus in Malta. Saratoga Greens says it's worried about the environmental impact of the factory.
